Plain T-shirts are available from most supermarkets and fabric pens (£1 from the Works).



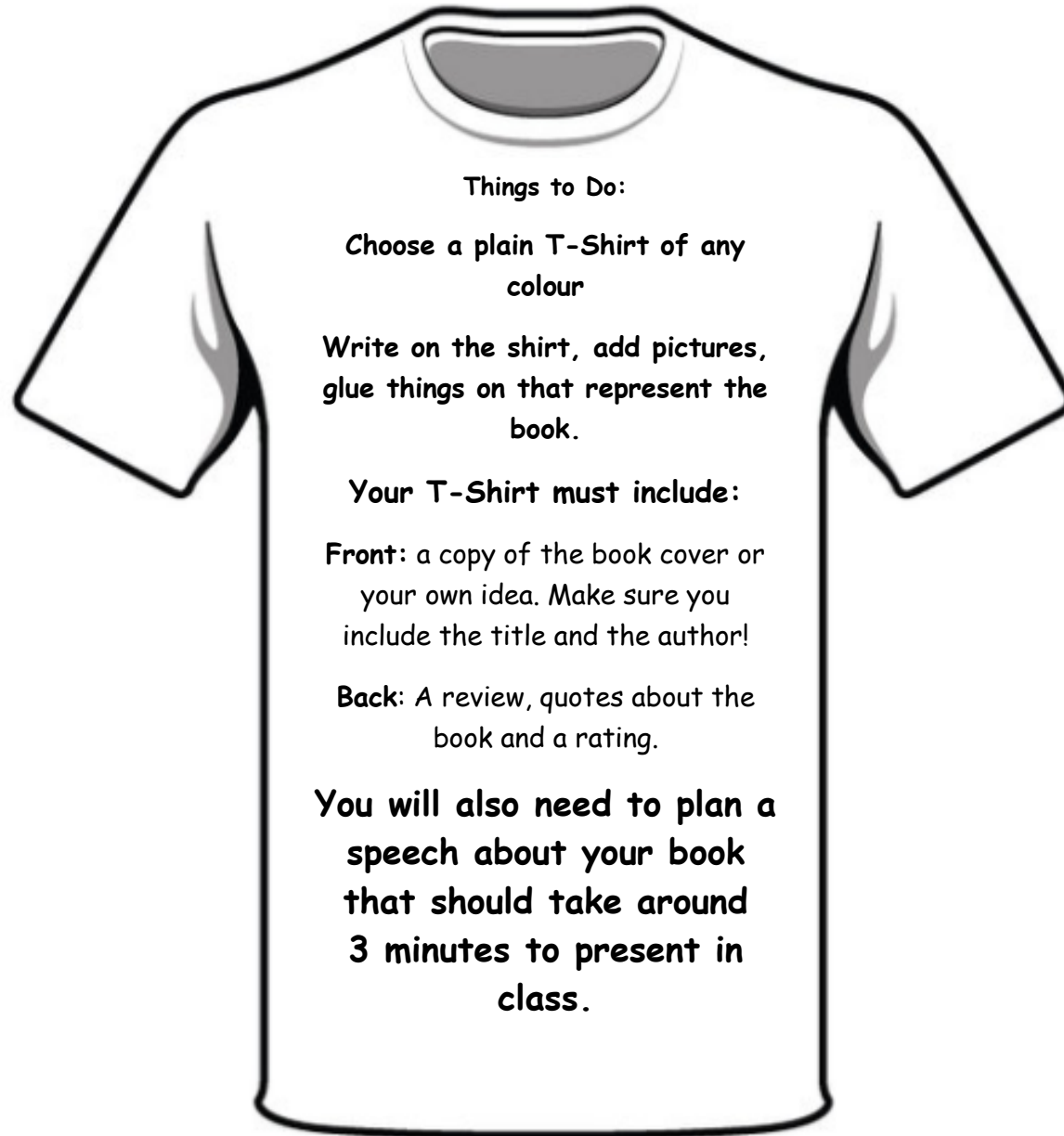
Classes will vote for a winner and they will be awarded a prize in assembly. To win, you need to follow the instructions on the opposite page.

Things to Do:

Choose a plain T-Shirt of any colour

Write on the shirt, add pictures, glue things on that represent the book.

Your T-Shirt must include:

Front: a copy of the book cover or your own idea. Make sure you include the title and the author!

Back: A review, quotes about the book and a rating.

You will also need to plan a speech about your book that should take around 3 minutes to present in class.
