

# Exam and Assessment Results

## Key Stage 2 end of Key Stage results for 2015-16

### Reading

67% (National 66%) of the children achieved the expected standard and above  
27% (National 19%) of the children achieved greater than expected standard

### Writing

86% (National 74%) of the children achieved the expected standard and above  
8% (National 15%) of the children achieved greater than expected standard

### Mathematics

55% (National 70%) of the children achieved the expected standard and above  
10% (National 17%) of the children achieved greater than expected standard

## Progress of pupils from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2

The progress score is calculated by comparing the scores attained at KS2 with the pupils KS1 baseline. A score of 0 indicates that pupils progress is in line with pupils nationally. A negative score shows that although pupils have made progress it is below that of others nationally. A positive score shows a better level of progress.
