### Key Stage 2 visit to the National Memorial Arboretum, Alrewas

We have arranged an exciting visit for our Year 5 and 6 pupils to the National Memorial Arboretum on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2024**.

Together with Royal British Legion, pupils will take part in a range of practical workshops to help them develop new skills to support their personal and cultural development.

This interactive event is a wonderfully unique opportunity for pupils to learn about UK Remembrance and its place in their lives today. Set in the educational, inspirational and natural environment of the National Memorial Arboretum, these Teaching Remembrance Days bring Remembrance to life for children in new, creative and diverse ways. Whilst there, our pupils will also get the opportunity explore the arboretum.

Pupils will be out of school for the full day, leaving promptly at 8.50am. They will be arriving back at school at approximately 3.00pm. Please ensure that your child is sent in the appropriate school uniform, sensible shoes and coat. Pupils will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or food containing nuts please). Pupils on free school meals can have a packed lunch provided by the school – orders must be placed with the kitchen by Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2024. If your child suffers from travel sickness please ensure you give them a sickness tablet and inform a member of staff.

Being fully subsidised by both external funding and the school, there will be no cost to parents for this visit.

As with all school visits, places are offered on an educational visit is conditional and may subsequently be reviewed by the Senior Leadership Team if a pupil's presence is identified as being potentially prejudicial to the health and safety of those participating in the visit.

The children will have an amazing day and will create the lasting memories that make their time at school so special and rewarding.
