## KS3 Personal, Social, Health, Citizenship and Economics Education

This half term, Year 7 and 8 pupils are studying the topic of 'Rights and Responsibilities' in their form on a Monday and Tuesday. This forms part of their Personal, Social, Health and Economics Education.

The module includes the following topics:

- Human rights and children's rights
- Forms of abuse including domestic, online, physical, emotional, neglect and sexual
- Child on child abuse
- Grooming and child sexual exploitation
- Trafficking
- Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)
- Forced marriage
- Breast ironing
- Online safety
- Safeguarding

In line with the national curriculum, children will be taught these topics in an age appropriate manner. There will be opportunities for pupils to explore the NSPCC website and understand how to seek help and support.
