### The Three Musketeers Theatre Visit – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2024

On Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2024, we have arranged a visit for all pupils to go to the New Vic Theatre in Stoke-on-Trent to see their Christmas production of ‘The Three Musketeers’.

The play is about a spirited country boy who arrives in the big city with big dreams and a streetwise city girl who spies her chance to steal the greatest prize of all.

We have booked tickets for the 10:30am performance, so we will return to school before the end of the day. I hope you will agree this visit will be a festive and fun experience for all children.

The school and FORM are subsidising a large part of the cost of this visit, and therefore, we would ask for a non-refundable payment of **£18.50**. The ticket price includes a vanilla ice cream during the interval – if your child is lactose intolerant and/or requires a vegan ice cream ordering please inform the office by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October at the latest.

Should the school receive insufficient funds, then unfortunately, this visit may have to be cancelled. Full School uniform must be worn. No mobile phones will be allowed on this visit.

Pupils will eat lunch on our return to school, we kindly request that all pupils bring a packed lunch in for the day (no glass/metal bottles or food containing nuts). If your child is in receipt of free school meals and would like the kitchen to prepare a lunch for them, please ask them to request this directly to the kitchen staff by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

If you would like your child to attend this visit, please pay £18.50 via your child’s Arbor account and tick the consent box by **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2024 at the very latest.**
