### Visit to the National Justice Museum

As part of our PSHCE, History and Computing curriculum, we are taking Year 8 pupils to the National Justice Museum in Nottingham on **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025** [nationaljusticemuseum.org.uk](http://nationaljusticemuseum.org.uk). The National Justice Museum inspires people of all ages to become active citizens. They do this through fun and engaging activities, exhibitions and educational programmes relating to law and justice.

They are based at Nottingham's historic Shire Hall and County Gaol where people can delve into the fascinating history of justice through time. The museum brings together elements of law and history through exhibits and interactive displays and activities. Pupils can find out more about crime and punishment from its medieval origins to the present-day UK and discover how law and justice contribute to all of our lives.

We consider this opportunity to be an invaluable experience for our pupils who hopefully will come away having had a fascinating day and with a fresh, new perspective on our legal system.

We would ask for a voluntary contribution of **£19.00** towards entrance fee and transport costs, however, if enough contributions are not made, the visit may not be viable and may be cancelled.

If your child receives free school meals and would like a school packed lunch, please ask your child to inform the school kitchen, by **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025**.
