Nottingham University Future Intentions Visit

As part of our future intentions provision for all year groups in the school, particularly our commitment to broadening the horizons of our Year 7 pupils, we have arranged a visit to the City of Nottingham University on **Thursday 27th March 2025**. Due to this visit being fully funded, there will be cost to parents.

The day will include a tour of the campus and surrounding area, where pupils will get a glimpse of university life and the facilities on offer. Pupils will also take part in workshops and listen to talks explaining the many pathways, opportunities and challenges to consider before furthering their education at university.

We aim to leave Ryecroft no later than 9:00am and return before the normal end of the school day, approximately 3:15pm. Pupils will need a packed lunch, drinks and snacks (no nuts, chewing gum, fizzy pop, glass or metal bottles) for the day. If your child receives free school meals and would like a school packed lunch, please ask your child to inform the school kitchen, by Friday 14th March 2025.

A small amount of spending money may be useful, however there is no guarantee there will anything to purchase during the day. Pupils are expected to arrive in their normal school uniform and will not be permitted to take their mobile phones with them on this visit.
